

How LETS Works

1. Local people set up a club to trade between themselves, keeping their own record of accounts
2. A directory of members' offers and requests' goods services or items for hire is compiled and published in the members secure area of our web site.
3. Members use the directory to contact one another whenever they wish. They pay for any service or goods by writing a LETS cheque for an agreed amount of Ebbles, or they agree an exchange of service or goods.
4. The cheque is sent to the LETS Treasurer who adjusts both members' accounts accordingly. Alternatively, the 'Buyer' may e-mail the Treasurer with the details of the transaction, ensuring that the full name of the 'Seller' is included. Every LETS member receives a personal account statement, directory updates and a newsletter, twice yearly

Unlike direct barter, with LETS you can earn credits (Ebbles) from any member and spend them with anyone else on the scheme.

LETS is non-profit making and interest-free. Service costs are covered by minimal charges on the accounts in Ebbles and an annual charge of £3.
